## *Draft Fort Worth Public Art Master Plan Update*

**The Fort Worth Art Commission** will conduct a Public Hearing on the Draft Fort Worth Public Art Master Plan Update, developed by Barbara Goldstein and Jessica Cusick based on input from residents throughout the city. The update to the original 2003 Master Plan comes 15 years after the Fort Worth Public Art program's establishment and seeks to "craft priorities and establish a collective vision for what public art can accomplish in Fort Worth in the next 15 years", according to Goldstein. The Plan will go before City Council for approval in September, 2017.
